

# Gold Coast and New Zealand June 9-22, 2018 World College Australia

Our programs develop leadership, English and life skills. (Accommodation in Melbourne can be in apartments or home stay or a combination of both. Dates can be changed. These itineraries are examples only)

### Saturday June 9

- Morning flight arrives at Brisbane International Airport.
   Welcome to Australia!
- When ready you will be led to the coach in coach parking area, Lebara sims will be given out on the coach (which hopefully will be already activated and thus working once put in the phone and waiting 30 minutes).
- It is 1 hour 20 minutes drive South to the Gold Coast. We will stop for a pre-ordered Hungry Jacks or Macdonalds for lunch on the highway down.
- 2pm Arrive at our accommodation. There are 8 apartments for the group. The apartments have 1 queen, 2 singles and 1-2 extra singles in each for 5-6 students per apartment. The apartments are nice.
- 2.45pm-3.30pm Meet at reception. In four groups we will do a 30 minute walk to the immediate area each led by one of our staff. This to show you the local shops and local park.
- 4pm Meet at reception where coach will take us to Surfers
   Paradise for dinner and to explore the beach. This is 15-20 minutes drive from our apartments.
- 4.20-6.20pm Time for photos at the beach before exploring Cavill Mall and Surfer's Paradise shops. Students will have \$10 each for dinner. Our staff will point out dinner options including an area with 8-10 Asian eateries but also Western choices.
- At 6.20pm we meet the coach and will be dropped back at our apartments at 06.50pm.
- 7.00-7.30pm Group meeting to welcome students and to go over some rules for looking after the apartments and safety. This will be in one of the apartments. Students also collect breakfast provisions from our leaders apartments.
- Students have free time this evening from 7pm. They may go to the local convenience store in groups with a leader with them until 8pm. After 8pm they should be in their apartments. After 9pm they should be in their own rooms and at 10pm it is lights out and electronics off.
- One or more leaders should meet our leader in charge once things are settled at their end to go through the next day in detail.





#### **Sunday June 10**

- 9am Meet at reception to take coach to Albert River Farm
- 10.10am Arrive at Albert River Farm for a farm show and tour. Students will see a sheep dog working the sheep, say hello to farm animals and be able to try whip cracking.
- 11.30am Lunch on the farm will be fish n chips n salad
- 12.30 Depart farm
- 1pm-2pm Arrive at Curtis Falls and do a 20 minute walk (one way) through beautiful rainforest to Curtis Falls and then return.
- 2.15-3.15pm Just nearby is Gallery Walk which is full of beautiful Village food and craft shops. Try the fudge or icecream or various speciality souvenir shops. This is a popular weekend destination for Brisbane and Gold Coast people and will be busy on this Sunday. Students will have 1 hour to explore a small but very nice village here.
- 3.30pm Depart Tambourine Mountain for the Gold Coast
- 4.30-6pm Time in Surfers Paradise to look around and have dinner. Students will be given \$10 each for dinner.
- 6pm Take coach back to our Apartments.
- 6.30pm Students have free time this evening from 6.30pm. They may go to the local convenience store or the nearby park in groups with a leader with them until 8pm. After 8pm they should be in their apartments. After 9pm they should be in their own rooms and at 10pm it is lights out and electronics off.

have class with Katie. We are likely to divide

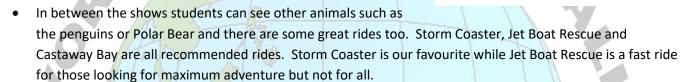
the two groups by age.

5pm-6.00pm Back in Parnell for some warm clothes and a shower after the snow

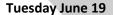


- 6.30-7.30pm We will walk to a local restaurant for dinner tonight.

- 07.50 Meet at reception bring your luggage

- 9.00am Depart on Coach for Okere Falls and a volcano
- 09.40am-10.30am Explore Okere Falls, famous for white water rafting and fast and beautiful rapids and falls
- 11.30-12.30 Mt Maunganui an extinct volcano coming up out of the coastline. We do a spectacular 1 hour walk around the base of this volcano with great ocean views. Wear shoes for walking
- 12.45-1.45pm Lunch at local shops in Mt Maunganui
- 2.20-3.20 Tauranga city and shops on the East coast. One hour free time to explore
- 4.00p-05.30pm Maclaren's Falls Park. Time to relax, explore a close waterfall. We will have some games here and some cup noodles, hot chocolate and fruit for dinner





- 5.30-6.00pm New Zealand is famous for glow worms and we are going to find you some. In a little fern gully after darkness there they are. Magical like fairy houses.
- 7.30pm Arrive back at our cabins. Students have free time this evening from 7.30pm. They may go to the local convenience store or the nearby park in groups with a leader with them until 8pm. After 8pm they should be in their apartments. After 9pm they should be in their own rooms and at 10pm it is lights out and electronics off.

- 9.00am Depart on Coach for Waiotapu mud pools and the thermal high way. This is unlike any road you have soon with steam coming out from the ground and mud pools bubbling away

- 08-10pm We have our own party back at the Cabin Centre. Students are to host it and may put on a talent show or disco or whatever they want within reason.

- 9.00am Depart on Coach for Lake Taupo
- 10.00am We stop at the Huka Huka falls to watch some of the fastest flowing water in the world. Legend has it that at least one Maori chief paddled a canoe over it.
- 11.30-1.30pm Barbecue by Lake Taupo. It is a great relaxing time with ball games, adventure play ground and time to chill and relax a little bit.
- 2-3pm There is a huge Bungy jump in Lake Taupo over a canyon. We will see if anyone is jumping off the bungy (we will be watching only)
- 3.30-4.00pm Honey tasting at Huka honey and the honey icecream is seriously Yum!
- 5.30-6.30pm Dinner in Rotorua or at our cabin park
